Main event information

Registration for the main event opens at 8am on Saturday and Sunday morning and closes at 9am sharp

All players must submit a deck list during registration. Players can submit paper deck list. Blank deck lists will be available at the venue. Deck lists must contain your BCC ID number. Deck lists cannot contain images of the cards in your deck. Card names/set numbers must be in writing.

Tournament Format

- Singles
- Constructed
- Best of 3 games, 60-minute matches.
- After swiss rounds players will cut to a top 8 single elimination bracket
- Mulligans and Side deck will not be enforced for this event

Side Event information

Price: £20

Format: 3 vs 3 teams (BO1)

Rules

- There is no sharing of cards in play. Each player uses their board and cannot cross between opponents.
- Up to 4 cards with the same card number can be used by the team. Up to 1 card can be used by the team for the 1-card limit card.
- Players need to register their team and decide who is Player A, Player B and Player C. These positions cannot be changed and are fixed until the end of the tournament.
- Players must decide on a team name when registering
- When determining matchups, Player A will always play against Player A of the opposing team, Player B will always play against Player B of the opposing team and Player C will always play against Player C.
- A team needs to win two of three games to be declared the winner
- Team's will need to win 2 games to be declared the winner. This event is BO1 Matches for each player.
- Match Time: 30 Minutes (End of time procedure will be followed based on Dragon Ball Super CG Rules)
- Players are not allowed to coach their fellow team members during matches.
- If players would like to enter the team event but don't have a team please report to tournament HQ on Saturday and we will do our best to find you a team
